What is Gift Aid?

Rules since April 2002 mean that a charity can reclaim tax if a donor is a taxpayer and signs a Declaration Form. It assists us greatly – and it does not cost you any more. All you need to do is sign the declaration on page one.

To enable the charity to reclaim the tax on your donation, you must pay income tax or capital gains tax which at least equals tax reclaimed in the tax year. Higher rate tax payers can claim further tax relief in the Self Assessment tax return.

If your circumstance change or you are unsure whether your donation(s) qualify for Gift Aid, write to the Hon. Treasurer at the Museum – or get leaflet IR113 from your local tax office.
