	Harlow District Council AB advised that Inspector ready to release final report. Will go to council on the 10 <sup>th</sup> December for adoption.
	Waltham Forest KB advised that two documents are currently out for consult – LP1 and LP2. LP1 is proposed submission which shall be out for Inspector Spring 2021. LP2 is for site allocations which is still in Reg 18, so another consult will be needed.
	Enfield Council IM advised that there was a round of DtoC meetings Summer 2020 and baseline evidence is being prepared. Currently working towards early 2021 for next plan iteration. IM also advised that consultation is due out for Green and Blue Infrastructure at the end of November.
	East Herts District Council CS advises that East Herts is anticipating a call for sites for the new year. No timeline has been confirmed yet. Regrading the Gilston area CS advises that there are amendments from Place for People for villages 1 to 6, and village 7 amends are not expected under December.
	CS advises Gilston Area Neighbourhood Plan is currently under examination – a hearing session scheduled for next Thursday.
	<u>LB Newham</u> CL advises that there is currently a consult out with GLA for the vision and principles.

	taking advantage of local outdoor spaces.
