This claim was filed and served earlier this month.

According to paragraph 5.3(a) of Practice Direction 8C of the Civil Procedure Rules, Acknowledgements of Service must be filed no later than 21 days after service of the claim.

No pre-action correspondence was conducted before the claim was filed. Therefore, the parties did not have the opportunity to narrow issues and focus grounds to the benefit of the Court.

I have written to the Claimant, Defendant, and all Interested Parties ("IPs") named on the claim form, on the applicant's behalf. In those letters, I stated the applicant's belief that the claim was served on the Defendant and IPs on 8 July 2021. I informed the Claimant, Defendant, and IPs that the applicant wished to apply to court for a two-week extension for the IPs to file Acknowledgments of Service.

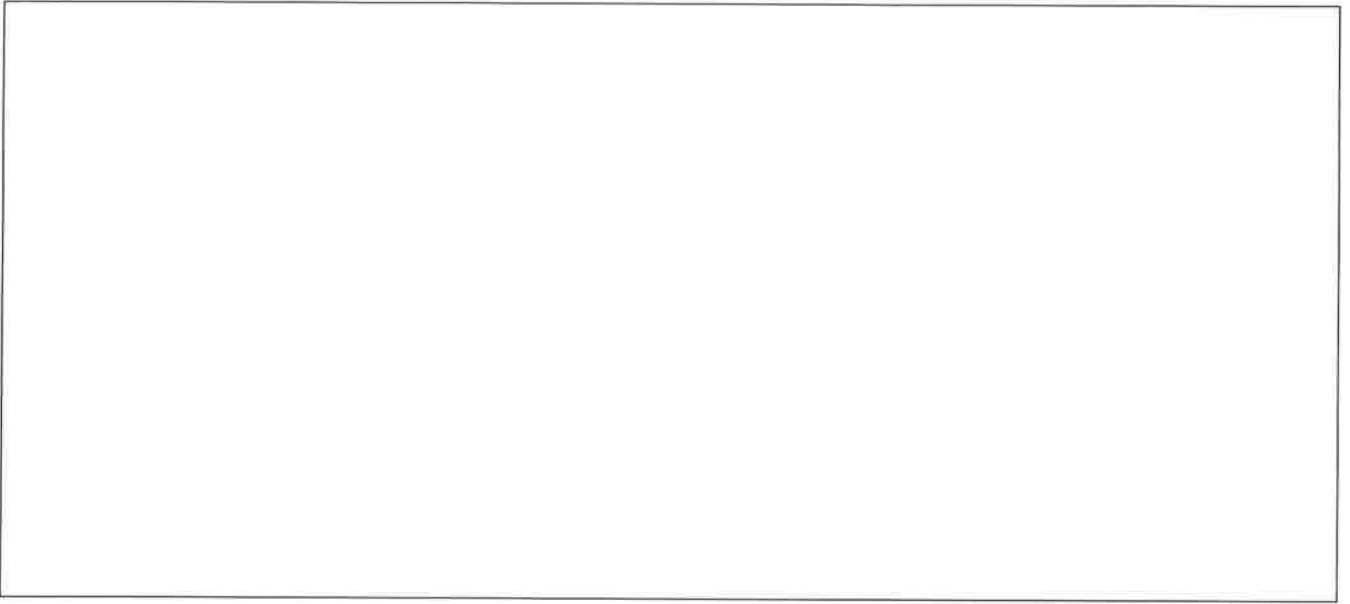
There is only one objector to the application, namely Stansted Airport Limited which is one of the Interested Parties. Stansted Airport Limited has not addressed the underlying reasons for the application or the obvious benefits it would offer to whichever judge considers the paper application for permission.

The Claimant and Defendant have confirmed in writing that they will not oppose this application. The Defendant mentioned, in their written response, that they consider that the deadline for filing their Acknowledgement of Service is 2 August 2021, taking into account the deemed service provision under CPR 6.14.

GALBA, one of the IPs, has confirmed in writing that they strongly support this application.

Copies of the letters that I have sent to the other parties in connection with this application, and the responses I have received, are annexed to this application at Annexure 1.

I therefore respectfully request that, in accordance with the court's general case management powers under CPR 3.1(2)(a), and in the interest of furthering the Court's overriding objective under CPR 1.1 to deal with cases justly and at proportionate cost, all IPs be allowed a two-week extension of time to file their Acknowledgments of Service. This will afford the IPs a two-week period to consider the Defendant's grounds before filing their Acknowledgments of Service.

We write in order to seek agreement to what we hope you will agree is a constructive procedural change to the filing date for all Interested Parties ("IP")s' Acknowledgment of Service ("AoS").

The Claimant served this claim on the Defendant and IPs on 8 July, 2021. According to paragraph 5.3(a) of Practice Direction 8C of the Civil Procedure Rules AoS's must therefore be filed by 30 July, 2021, i.e. by no later than 21 days after service.

In cases in which there has been pre-action correspondence between a claimant and a defendant, IPs filing an AoS would be able to focus their summary grounds on the issues which exist between those parties as would be apparent on the face of that correspondence. Clearly this has the advantage of providing the parties with the opportunity to narrow issues and focus grounds to the benefit of the Court. That opportunity is absent in this claim where no pre-action correspondence was conducted before the claim was filed. Uttlesford District Council v Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government (CO/2356/2021)

We act for the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government in the above proceeding.

We refer to your letter dated 19 July 2021, in which you have:

- Confirmed that your client will make an application for a 2-week extension of time for it and any other interested parties to file an Acknowledgment of Service ("AoS").
- Requested our client's agreement to the extension.

Our client takes a neutral position in respect of the proposed application. We do however make the following observations:

- We agree that the parties are unable to agree to an extension of time due to Practice Direction 8C (paragraph 5.4).
- It is possible that the parties will make submissions to the effect that the proceeding should be categorised as a "Significant Planning Court claim" under which accelerated target dates apply to various stages in the proceeding. If so, the proposed application may materially impact the Court's capacity to meet those target dates.

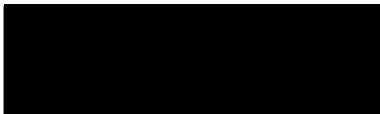
