Saffron Walden Neighbourhood Plan

Firstly, thank you for your examiners note received on 8th February 2022, providing some very useful feedback and advice. Upon receipt of your advice, we raised a number of queries with UDC, seeking clarification on the process and feedback on some of the issues raised and again, thank you for those responses received via UDC.

Your report was presented to the Town Council's Full Council meeting on Monday 14th February 2022; it was taken as a confidential item so as to not prejudice any statutory public consultation / information period. At this meeting, Council agreed to hold in abeyance any strategic decision on your comments, this given the number of queries outstanding at that time.

We have since received advice and responses from all of our queries (again, thank you to you and UDC for those responses) and we have called an additional Full Council meeting for Wednesday 23rd February to discuss the options going forward. At this meeting, Council will consider all of the options available, using additional supporting material provided by Officers. It is anticipated that at this meeting, Council will determine its preference in progressing with the Saffron Walden Neighbourhood Plan.
