



What can I comment on?

The Regulation 19 stage is different to the Regulation 18 stage (that we completed last year) as the responses are forwarded to the Planning Inspector who will preside over the process to determine if the Plan can be 'adopted'. At the Regulation 19 stage, any comments must be made on the following matters:

Soundness

Has the Plan been positively prepared, is it justified, effective and consistent with national planning policy?

Legal Compliance

Does it meet the legal requirements made under the relevant statutes?

Compliant with the Duty to Cooperate

Has the Council engaged and worked effectively with neighbouring authorities and relevant statutory bodies?

These matters relate to the planning legislation, policy and guidance for Local Plans and the Planning Inspector will use to determine if the Plan is capable of being adopted.
