- 4. The applicant shall send a copy of the application to Essex Police (Braintree Licensing Unit) not later than 7 days after the date of this application.
- 5. A licence cannot be granted to:
 - (a) A person under 18.
 - (b) A person whose licence has been revoked.
 - (c) Persons, other than companies, who are not resident in the United Kingdom.
 - (d) A company not incorporated in the United Kingdom.
 - (e) Persons who have, within 12 months preceding application, been refused a licence.
- 6. The application form must be returned to the Licensing Section, Uttlesford District Council, Council Offices, London Road, Saffron Walden, Essex. CB11 4ER, together with the appropriate fee.
