1. An application must be accompanied by the prescribed fee.
2. The applicant shall give public notice of the application by having a notice (in the form attached) published in a local newspaper, circulating in the Council's area not later than 7 days after the date of application.
3. Where the application is in respect of premises, the applicant shall also display a notice of the application (in the form attached) for 21 days beginning with the date of the application on or near the premises and in a place where the notice can conveniently be read by the public.  
(A notice relating to a vehicle, vessel or stall shall specify where it is to be used as a sex establishment)
4. The applicant shall send a copy of the application to Essex Police (Braintree Licensing Unit) not later than 7 days after the date of this application.
5. A licence cannot be granted to:
  - (a) A person under 18.
  - (b) A person whose licence has been revoked.
  - (c) Persons, other than companies, who are not resident in the United Kingdom.
  - (d) A company not incorporated in the United Kingdom.
  - (e) Persons who have, within 12 months preceding application, been refused a licence.
6. The application form must be returned to the Licensing Section, Uttlesford District Council, Council Offices, London Road, Saffron Walden, Essex. CB11 4ER, together with the appropriate fee.
