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Introduction

The following report has been commissioned by Uttlesford District Council in response to the Uttlesford Draft Local Plan. An assessment has been undertaken of the likely impacts of development on the known historic environment resource recorded on the Historic Environment Record. The archaeological implications sections identifies: 1) Sites which have historic environment requirements (highlighted in grey), either in the form of work needed to support any future planning application, or where archaeological work is still required to fulfil planning conditions on existing applications, 2) allocated sites which have already been archaeologically assessed, 3) sites where there are no archaeological requirements.

Land at Holmwood, Whiteditch Lane, Newport	12	Will require a programme of trial trenching and potential excavation before development commences.

Former Willis and Gambier Site, 121 Radwinter Road, Saffron Walden	52	Limited archaeological potential, due to modern buildings, however, any layout should consider the line of the historic railway through the western part of the site.

Will require archaeological evaluation in advance of the planning application Edge of site lies on the line of the medieval town defences. The archaeological constraint needs to be added to the other elements here.

56 High Street, Saffron Walden	10	Located in the centre of the historic town of Saffron Walden inside the town defensive ditches. This is a sensitive area of the town and will require a desk based assessment and evaluation to identify the extent and nature of surviving archaeological deposits.
2 Lower Street, Stansted Mountfitchet	14	Archaeologically evaluated but already badly disturbed. Close to the Scheduled Mott and Bailey Castle
Land at Walpole Farm, Stansted Mountfitchet	147	Archaeologically evaluated, one small area of archaeological features which has been excavated.
Mead Court, Stansted Mountfitchet	29	no impact
Land at Elms Farm, Stansted Mountfitchet	53	Archaeologically evaluated, peat deposits located in flood plain. Awaiting report.
Land west of 8 Water Lane, Stansted Mountfitchet.	12	On site of former gas works and within area of historic settlement. Requires archaeological investigation
Land east of Cambridge Road (B1383) and west of High Lane, Stansted	40	Windmill located on opposite side of road, will require a trenching assessment and excavation if approved.
