

Housing Options Help Sheet: Parental Evictions

What you may need to do	What we may do
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tell us about why there has been a breakdown and why you cannot continue to stay at home • Give us the names, addresses and contact number for parents 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Speak to your parent(s)/ guardian(s) and hear from them why they are asking you to leave. • Consider if it is reasonable for you to go home
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give us the contact details of any practitioners involved, any support workers/ Social Care? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will advise you if we think you would benefit from additional support and will look into how well you are engaging with the services offered to you – including tenancy sustainment. We can refer to other agencies such as Peabody who can take action to help you keep your home.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tell us about your income and expenditure 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide general benefit advice, refer to CAB or online sources to get advice on income maximisation • Investigate sources of financial assistance for costs (Saffron Walden United Charities/ DHP/ Prevention Fund)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will need to tell us about the type of property you need • Consider alternative accommodation • Think about other family that you could live with 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will assess your basic housing needs, your age will affect your options • Advise on possibility of supported accommodation • Advise on possibility of privately renting • Advise on eligibility for the Home Option scheme
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will want you to provide evidence of anything that makes you more vulnerable such as health & wellbeing issues 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We may contact others to find out more about your vulnerabilities and advise you about how this may influence your application
