COUNCIL TAX ONLINE – CANCELLING A SINGLE PERSON DISCOUNT

Important: By law the Council must be informed of any changes that may affect any discount. A penalty can be imposed if a taxpayer fails to do so.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO REGISTER TO DO THIS

Introduction

This guide provides a step by step instruction on how to use the Council Tax Online Service to cancel a Single Person Discount. This can occur if a second adult moves in with you. You will to enter your Council Tax account number, an 8 digit number starting with a 4 or a 5 that can be found on our Council Tax Bill.

Step 1 – go the Council Tax home page at <u>https://www.uttlesford.gov.uk/counciltax</u>

Step 2 - select 'Manage your Council Tax online'



Step 3 – Under Apply to reduce your Council Tax select 'View ways to reduce your council tax' then select 'I want to cancel a single person discount'
